Yellow-brown, amorphous powder. Odorless.

Slightly toxic by ingestion and inhalation. Irritating to body tissues. Avoid all body tissue contact.

Strong oxidizer.

SECTION 4 — FIRST AID MEASURES

Call a physician and seek medical attention for further treatment, observation, and support after first aid.

Inhalation: Remove to fresh air at once. If breathing has stopped, give artificial respiration immediately.

Eye or External: Immediately flush with fresh water for at least 15 minutes.

Internal: Rinse mouth. Give large quantities of water for dilution. Call a physician or poison control at once.

SECTION 5 — FIRE FIGHTING MEASURES

Nonflammable solid.

Strong oxidizer; may be a fire hazard when in contact with combustible materials.

Fire Fighting Instructions: Use triclass, dry chemical fire extinguisher. Firefighters should wear PPE and SCBA with full facepiece operated in positive mode.

SECTION 7 — HANDLING AND STORAGE

Flinn Suggested Chemical Storage Pattern: Inorganic #7. Store with arsenates, cyanides and cyanates.

Store in a cool dry place. Store in a Flinn Chem-Saf bag. Use and dispense in a hood.

SECTION 8 — EXPOSURE CONTROLS, PERSONAL PROTECTION

Avoid contact with eyes, skin, and clothing. Wear chemical splash goggles, chemical-resistant gloves, and chemical-resistant apron.

Yellow-brown, amorphous powder. Odorless.

Solubility: Insoluble in cold water. Decomposes in hot water and acids.

Shelf life: Fair, somewhat hygroscopic; slowly decomposes on storage. Store in a Flinn Chem-Saf bag.
